**Minister’s Message**

*“[Jesus] led them out of the city over to Bethany. Raising his hands he blessed them, and while blessing them, took his leave, being carried up to heaven. And they were on their knees, worshipping him. They returned to Jerusalem bursting with joy. They spent all their time in the Temple praising God. Yes.” (Luke 24:50-53 The Message)*

In living life, we can’t escape change. Throughout our lives we encounter changes in health, wealth, birth, death, communities, friendships and families. Change also happens in our church, with people coming and going and changes to what we do and how we do things. It just may be we don’t always make that connection that things have changed. Those of you who attended our Parish meeting in March will remember the discussions around our participation in UnitingCare’s Connect100 project and how this will change my role within the parish and the wider Uniting Church through a direct involvement with UnitingCare. For me, with

the commencement of one day a week in this role since 1 April, it has not been an easy transition as we are still putting supports in place that will lessen my workload within our parish.

Just as Jesus' disciples' lives changed after Jesus' death, resurrection and ascension into heaven the way we do church will change as others enter into the worship space. This is an evolving space and I ask for your prayer and support through this time of change. Essentially this will mean that I will be preaching a little less as I focus on rebuilding our relationship with Lifeline, Blue Care and UnitingCare in the Maryborough district. Since February last year I have been involved in St Stephen's Hospital Consumer Advisory Committee. This is a space where I hear directly from management about what is happening in the hospital as well as I am given an opportunity to let management know of any difficulties members of our congregation may have encountered as patients of the hospital. The hospital is always open to feedback, both negative and positive, from their patients so they can improve health outcomes.

Jesus' disciples were filled with joy at a time when one would think they should have been weeping, but they saw the bigger picture of their part in God's story. They knew that Jesus' resurrection was a good news story that needed to be spread throughout the world. Where will we find the joy in this time of change? For me, it is in the work of the Holy Spirit that has brought us to a space within the church where once again all entities of the church can function together within Maryborough, Tiaro and Bauple for the good of our communities.

Let us pray: ***God of love, open our hearts and minds to what this change will mean for your kingdom here on earth. Bless all who work and volunteer for UnitingCare. Help us to find ways to encourage and support them that will bless our communities. Be with us Lord Jesus and give us the strength and courage to step out into an unknown path. Amen.***
