Minister's Message

Dear Friends

How long, Lord? Will you forget me forever? How long will you hide your face from me? How long must I wrestle with my thoughts and day after day have sorrow in my heart? How long will my enemy triumph over me? Look on me and answer, Lord my God. Give light to my eyes, or I will sleep in death, and my enemy will say, "I have overcome him," and my foes will rejoice when I fall. But I trust in your unfailing love; my heart rejoices in your salvation. I will sing the Lord's praise, for he has been good to me. (Psalm 13 NIV)

As I write this, I am sitting in Queen's Park overlooking the river where the damage from the floods is still evident. It is easy to focus on the damage as we mourn how things used to be in this beautiful park that usually showcases the beauty of God's creation. What we can miss though is seeing what has changed and regenerated since the inundation

of floodwaters, not once but twice. The park is resilient, it has been through this many times before. It is bringing forth new life despite the damage it sustained. We too can focus on our pain when life is going through a bumpy patch and may miss the things, we can give thanks for.

When life gets bumpy, as it has been this year, we can lose sight of the fact that we have been down bumpy paths before. Yes, it may have been a different bumpy path, but the thing is we survived those other bumpy paths and are still here to tell our story. Churches have bumpy paths too but continue to survive and some can regenerate and thrive. How do we get through the bumpy paths? We get through because it is in those bumpy times that we dig deeper into our faith and pray. The Psalmist reminds us of this. We continually cry out to God in our pain, God hears our cry and responds. God just may not respond as we would like. We too, like the Psalmist, can trust in God's unfailing love, we can rejoice in our salvation and sing God's praise as God has been good to us. This is the Good News we can share out in the world, in our homes, in our communities, that God hears our pain and responds.

Today as I write this, I am wearing my new UnitingCare Connect100 name tag and it reminds me that I have been down this path before, but my context in this space now is different than it was nine years ago. I can give thanks to a God who has loved me and been faithful to me through some very bumpy paths to get me to this place helping to rebuild the relationship between our parish, the UnitingCare agencies and our local communities. Let us give thanks to a faithful God as we step out in faith on this new path that will at times be bumpy, but when we place our trust in God we can embrace this time and open our hearts and minds to the work of the Holy Spirit as we follow Christ.
