Minister's Message



Dear Friends

"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart." (Jeremiah 29:11-13 NIV)

Wow! What a year we had in 2022! Perhaps for you 2022 was a year full of wonderful memories. I know it was for me, but it was also a year of great challenges. If you remember the year started with a bang! On 1 January the Qld government announced the mandated wearing of masks. There was another COVID wave that would impact us like none of the other waves as this brought our first

community transmission. A week later our city was inundated with a major flood event followed six weeks later by an even bigger major flood event. I think this set the scene for our year as we navigated cancellations and postponements of church services, meetings, community events and medical appointments. Through all of the continual upheaval we had one constant, a faithful God who was with us every step of the way. God has plans to give us hope and a future.

This well-known and loved passage from Jeremiah is a favourite of mine. At the start of chapter 29 Jeremiah sends a message from God (v8) in the form of a letter, from Jerusalem to what was left of the elders exiled in Babylon (v1-2). The people were the remnants of the last surviving tribe of Israel, Judah, had been captured and dispersed throughout Babylon in 587 BC. The letter tells them that God is with them. God has plans for their lives and has not deserted them in their suffering. God's message was that they were to settle where they were, build homes, and gardens, bear children and they would prosper in this land. God would show up after seventy years in exile and they would eventually be free people once again. Jeremiah's letter rebuked and challenged the exiles: Quit sitting around feeling sorry for yourselves. The aim of people of faith isn't to be as comfortable as possible but to live as fully as possible. Don't just survive, thrive.

In looking back at the year that was, we too can see that we have not sat still feeling sorry for ourselves. On 1 April we began a journey forming a new relationship with UnitingCare through Connect100. In our region UnitingCare has a large footprint within the wider community with Lifeline shops, Lifeline Crisis Support 131114, Lifeline Community Recovery, UnitingCare counselling services (family, gambling and financial), Blue Care community care and respite centre and St Stephen's Hospital. I look forward to seeing where God might be leading us in this space next year.

For our Parish, we have also been through a time of prayer and discernment and next year will enter into a new phase with the change to our leadership structure. Congratulations to Robyn (Maryborough congregational Secretary) and the members of our new structured Leaders Council, Linda, Sybil, Marion, Diana, Denise, Ros and Bruce who will meet every month next year starting in January. I appreciate your accepting God's call on your lives and the commitment you have made to the Parish and to God's mission in the world.

Let us continue to call on God and pray for God's leading in our discernment in 2023 as we 'make Christ visible' in the communities of Maryborough, Tiaro and Bauple. May you all be blessed as we celebrate the birth or our Lord Jesus Christ and may you feel God's presence throughout the Christmas season and into the New Year.
