Minister's Message



Dear Friends

Just as our bodies have many parts and each part has a special function, so it is with Christ's body. We are many parts of one body, and we all belong to each other. (Romans 12:4-5 NLT)

Have you ever heard the story of the minister who arrived at church on Sunday morning and said: "my apologies everyone, so much has happened this week and I just didn't have time to prepare a sermon." Well I'm feeling a bit like that this week, except I haven't quite run out of time to write my sermon...yet. It's Thursday night and I have almost run out of time to write something for the Bulletin. This can happen when it is one of my busier weeks and then there are extras like preparing to host Presbytery, writing something for the Bulletin, knowing I still must prepare three reports, write a sermon and read the Presbytery reports... Throw into the mix spending a few hours preparing a church service because no one else wants to do it, then having to spend time finding people to help lead the service whilst I'm away and things start going pear shaped.

Welcome to a very small snapshot of my week. Sometimes there just aren't enough hours in the week to do all the things that need to be done to keep the wheels turning. Let's face facts: I have not been a fulltime minister for the past year. I now work one day a week in the UnitingCare Connect100 space, which means one day less to do all those other tasks for the Parish.

The thing is that when we can't get enough helpers, even for the smaller less time consuming, less physical things, it's the parish that suffers and God's kingdom diminishes. The light on the hill dims and fades away. We are many parts that make up the whole of the Parish and when we work together, all using our spiritual gifts, amazing things can happen as we work together under the command and authority of Jesus Christ. If you don't believe me, come and visit our Breakfast Ministry on a Tuesday morning and see our volunteers (most 60 to 80+) in action, cooking, serving, talking, cleaning and washing dishes in the heat, in the early morning and see the people who leave with a full stomach and a satisfied look on their faces. This is how discipleship can extend beyond the walls of the church into our community, 'making Christ visible.' Let us give thanks for all our volunteers who give of their time willingly and in so many ways and with a glad heart shining a light into the world. We are looking for more helpers for the roster on Sunday mornings and at Breakfast Ministry. Is there something you can do to help, even in a small way, that will lighten the load? Now... it's past my bedtime!


