## Minister's Message



Dear Friends

There are different kinds of spiritual gifts, but the same Spirit gives them. There are different ways of serving, but the same Lord is served. There are different abilities to perform service, but the same God gives ability to all for their particular service. The Spirit's presence is shown in some way in each person for the good of all.

(1 Corinthians 12:4-7 GNT)

We all have spiritual gifts. God has gifted each of us with different abilities that are to be used for the good of all. Often we can be blind to what our gifts are. We think we know ourselves well but we don't really. We can have blind spots to our gifts and to our weaknesses. I knew someone once who had decided that she must have been hiding when spiritual gifts were

handed out as she thought she only had one. Those who knew her well could see that she had a few more than one. It is easy to be down on ourselves, especially if we start comparing ourselves to others whose gifts may be so exceptional that they shine brightly out into the world. Perhaps we may think that our gifts aren't anything special, although the Bible tells us that each gift is important. Not everyone has the gift of hospitality, or preaching, or caring for others pastorally. Some do what others may consider the boring tasks of administration, attending meetings, making decisions, writing emails and reports, paying the bills, and do it willingly as they enjoy this type of work.

It is amazing that when you are using your spiritual gifts your heart will sing as you enjoy doing it so much, whereas when you are doing tasks just because they need to be done and nobody else wants to do them, you may not feel joyful at all and actually complain and grumble your way through, zapping the joy right out of you. What are the things you do in life that put a zing in your step, a smile on your face, and joy in your heart? These are the things that are lifegiving and fill your spiritual cup to overflowing. Just be warned though that when it overflows, there is the risk that it will spill into the lives of the people you spend time with, whether for a moment or a lifetime. This is the Holy Spirit breaking into the world, changing it forever.

We have left Lent behind for another year and by the end of May we will leave the Easter season behind. On 28 May Pentecost will once again burst into our lives. This can be a time of renewal if we let it. Jesus' disciples stood huddled in the locked room when he suddenly appeared to them, *took a deep breath and breathed into them, "Receive the Holy Spirit"* (John 20: 23 The Message) and their lives were changed forever. Will you let Pentecost pass you by, or will you risk letting the Holy Spirit enter into your life, beckoning you to use those God given gifts? Perhaps someone who knows you well might be able to point out to you what some of your gifts are so you can share them with the world for the common good, helping to create a piece of heaven right here on Earth.
