

# Minister's Message



Dear Friends

Do not long for the "good old days," This is not wise. (Ecclesiastes 7:10 NLT)

But the Lord says, "Do not cling to events of the past or dwell on what happened long ago. Watch for the new thing I am going to do. It is happening already-you can see it now! I will make a road through the wilderness and give you streams of water there. (Isaiah 43:18-19 GNT)

Anniversaries and birthdays. We can mark our lives by them. Each time we celebrate (or bemoan) getting older we know that another year has passed us by. Sometimes we may be glad as we remember the previous years but sometimes, we may be sad feeling we missed opportunities and moments in time that we will never get back again. For our church June was a time when we reflected on 46 years since the inauguration of the Uniting Church in Australia. Another quieter celebration was the marking of 59 years since 2nd Maryborough Girls' Brigade was formed. Often when we look back on those 'good old times' we using our rose-coloured are glasses, remembering only the good times. They are easy and nostalgic to talk about, but they may never have existed.

The 'good old times' often only exist in our memories because we gloss over and choose to forget that those days also had problems and challenges. Perhaps this is how we survive, by looking back through our rose-coloured glasses.

Recently I travelled to Brisbane and there was fog that delayed my trip. By the time it had cleared enough for safer visibility there were still patches. Driving through these patches of fog I reflected on how the fog dims the view to the front, sides and rear, nothing is clear about where we are going or where we have come from. At the inauguration service for the Uniting Church on 22 June 1977 the first President, Rev Dr Davis McCaughey, asked four pertinent questions: "Where did you come from?" "Where are you going?" "Who are you?" "Are you and I prepared to find our bearings afresh?" I find these questions still resonate today. We can look back at the past to see where we have come from and often that is where we can get stuck. By looking back we don't have to face the difficult questions about where we might be going and who are we as the people of God today in a world that has changed dramatically in the past 46 years. We just need to look back at some happenings of 1977: Star Wars opens in cinemas, First Apple II computers go on sale, Elvis Presley dies at the age of 42, Queen Elizabeth II celebrates 25 years on the throne. Wow! Don't we remember most of those as though they were only yesterday? So how might we look to an unknown future so that we can find our bearings afresh as God's people on the way? Just as the Israelites were being led out of darkness into a new thing God would do, through prayer and stillness and looking at the world around us we might get a glimpse of the new thing God is doing in the world around us. Let us use our eyes to see, our ears to listen and let our heart be renewed. I wonder what God is challenging us to do God bless afresh in our personal lives, in our church and in our local community?

### REPORT ON 26 JUNE 2023 MEETING OF LEADERS COUNCIL

Approval was given for the following:

- A trifold brochure to be produced highlighting the missional activities of the Church.
- An updated evacuation procedure for St Stephen's Church.
- Bonza Book Sale to be held in Wesley Auditorium on 12 August 2023.
- November Noel to be held on 25 November 2023.

There was initial discussion on two matters:

- Start time for Sunday services at St Stephens, particularly in Winter.
- Need for a Set Down bay at the back of St Stephens.

Other matters discussed included:

- Paths and paving around the Chapel at the West Complex will be replaced with concrete, to make them safer.
- Girls Brigade Leaders will host a morning tea with Leaders Council members on 8 July.
- Parish Tea will not be held in July and August, and resume with warmer weather in September.
