

Minister's Message



Dear Friends

*Now when David had served God's purpose in his own generation, he fell asleep; he was buried with his ancestors and his body decayed." (Ads 13:36 NIV)

"There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens: a time to be born and a time to die, a time to plant and a time to uproot, a time to kill and a time to heal, a time to tear down and a time to build..." (Ecclesiastes 3:1-13 NIV)

With a theme of "Renewal: Faith for a New Season." I should have realised that the 37th Qld Synod would be a time to put aside the everyday to explore where there may be green shoots arising from the ashes of the past. Pastor Katie from South Australia's Journey Uniting Church challenged me with her bible study by drawing on insights from creation into the character of God and the nature of renewal. I was taken on a tour through cellular biology, where I discovered that in the renewal of any given body, new growth, differentiation, and necessary endings are three needed and intertwined elements. "Part of renewal is understanding what necessary endings look like," Katie said, "so if we want to renew the church, we need to look at what needs to grow, what needs to change, and what needs to die." Katie's reflection on renewal was offered against the overarching question, drawn from Acts 13:36, of whether we are serving the purposes of God in our generation. To guote Ecclesiastes: *There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens." The most difficult part is what do we need to 'tear down' and what do we need to 'build?'

I was then challenged anew by St Lucia Uniting Church's Pastor, Mandy Smith's, Bible study where she drew on the striking imagery of a tree planted by the water (Jer 17:5-8). Mandy led the Synod in a deep and at times challenging reflection on what it means to live and depend wholly on God. "What does it mean to live" Mandy asked, "as if we really believe He is the answer to every question, the resolution to every crisis, the preacher of every sermon, the chair of every church council, the leader of every community?" Going further, she observed that renewal starts with us each individually taking this posture: "Fundamentally renewal is a human heart turning to God once more, remembering that habit". Mandy closed with a powerful call to prayer, noting that "every renewal movement I have heard of through the history of the church has not happened without prayer."

Amen


'Uniting for Mental Health' at Maryborough Markets, 12 October 2023.




