

MINISTER'S MESSAGE

Dear Friends

[Jesus said] "Therefore, go and make disciples of all the peoples, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age." (Matthew 28:19-20 NLT)

Do you start searching for something and get totally sidetracked? You look for a certain photo and spend a whole day reminiscing with a hundred other photos and don't even find the one you were looking for or you try to Google something on the internet and find out some interesting information but nothing about what you were originally looking for. It is so easy to get sidetracked especially if what we were originally wanting to do might create some work or bring up some strong emotions. Being a Christian isn't easy. Being the church in 2024 isn't easy. Jesus didn't tell us that being his disciples would be easy. Jesus said in Luke 9:23 (NLT), "If any of you wants to be my follower, you must give up your own way, take up your cross daily, and follow me." I often wonder how much we get sidetracked as a church and individually from Jesus' commission to: "go and make disciples of all the peoples, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit."

It sounds such a simple commission, but Jesus doesn't give us simple instructions on how to live this out. How could he? Two thousand years on, we live on the other side of the world and our context is far removed from

the world of the disciples. The world has changed even in the past 47 years since we became the Uniting Church in Australia. Through the writing of the disciples and of Paul we can delve into the living word that is the Bible to get a glimpse of what Jesus is calling us to go and do out beyond the walls of our church building. Before we go out into the world, we might need to be reminded that: "To be a Christian is to know who God really is (Christ, the one who has been given all authority) and thereby to know who we really are, why we were created, why God has convened us as the church (as the authorized who are to "go")." (William H Willimon.)

Lord Jesus, you have called us to follow you into a ministry of reconciling people to God and to one another, to be peacemakers in our world. Paul reminds us: "Do everything possible on your part to live in peace with everybody" (Romans 12:18 GNT).

But Lord, this is not easy. Sometimes we want to be in control and ignore what you are calling us to do, and we neglect opportunities to bring your peace into a situation. Please help us Lord, open our hearts to your will. Renew our minds and open our eyes to new possibilities.

Refresh us and renew us so that we can begin again, pouring out your love into the lives of our families, friends, people in our communities and within your body, the Church. Encourage and strengthen us to help bring peace into a fractured, hurting world. Amen.


