Report on Leaders' Council Meeting 26 August 2024

Approval was given for the following:

- Leave for Rev Delma from Tuesday, 24 September to Monday, 30 September 2024.
- Brisbane Festival Male Voice Choir to hold its Gospel in Song presentation in St Stephen's Church on 21 June 2025.
- Men's Shelter Appeal to be conducted during October 2024.

Leaders Council also noted that the internal auditor, Irene Leegwater, had found the 2023/4 financial records to be satisfactory for the Parish groups – MUCAF, Girls Brigade, Breakfast Ministry and Country Fellowship. Irene's assistance is very much appreciated.

Leaders Council confirmed its support for MUCAF, the Adult Fellowship Group which actively provides hospitality, enjoys social interaction, supports missional and fund raising activities, and funds Auditorium cleaning. It encourages as many members of the congregation who are able to support this Group which currently needs a Secretary and Treasurer to continue.

Leaders Council considered matters directed to it from the Annual Parish Meeting and action is being initiated on the following:

- Identifying assistance available for any grant applications it may decide to undertake regarding property repair.
- Finalising the 2024/5 budget.
- Sorting out financial responsibilities to commence from January 2025.

Leaders Council confirmed that it would focus on resolving the current property issues before taking a longer term view of the Parish's property holdings.
