

## MINISTER'S MESSAGE

#### **Dear Friends**

...fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand. (Isaiah 41:10 MSG)

Fear can be overpowering. It can stop us in our tracks and zap the life out of us. We can be fearful about our health, our family situation, what is happening in our community, our country, and our world. Fear is often fuelled by a lack of knowledge about what we are fearful of. If we are fearful about a health diagnosis, it can be empowering to gain knowledge about what it might mean for our day-to-day life. For some people who fear what is happening in our community they may even stop venturing outside their homes. It is hard to believe that in March 2025 it will be five years since we first felt fear about COVID-19. The remnants of the Israelites who were living in exile in Babylon where fearful that God had forgotten them and that God's presence in the world had shrunken and withered. The Israelites were isolated far from their homeland but in two generations they had become acclimatised to life in Babylon. They had come to terms with their conquerors. They had assimilated into the culture. They were worried about rumours of another power rising in the East, an

assimilated into the culture. They were worried about rumours of another power rising in the East, an unknown ruler who was sweeping the land and there was panic.

Then along comes the prophet, Isaiah. He had a message for God's people. 'Don't panic. I am with you. There is no need to fear for I'm your God. I'll give you strength. I'll help you." What a powerful message for them to hear and for us to hear as well. God is with us. Do not be afraid. All will be well. This doesn't mean that there won't be challenges to deal with or suffering to live through, but through all that God can be our refuge and strength. Fear unchecked can paralyse us from doing anything other than huddling up, hiding away trying to stay safe. We can worry about things that may or may not happen. This crippling worry can also stop us from stepping out of our comfort zone into doing things differently. This Advent and Christmas I will be using the Qld Synod Discipleship Group worship resource for church services. The theme is "Rejoice together one and all." The themes will be Rejoice and See; Rejoice and Hear; Rejoice and Act; Rejoice and Feel; Rejoice and Celebrate: Rejoice and Know. When we are struggling, how can we stop ourselves from being stuck in fear whatever our fear maybe? God loves you and is with you. May you feel God's loving embrace give you comfort and peace during Advent, Christmas and into the New Year and beyond. *May the* 

grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all. (2 Corinthians 13:14 NLT)
