MINISTER'S MESSAGE

Dear Friends

Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take. Don't be impressed with your own wisdom. Instead, fear the Lord and turn away from evil. (Proverbs 3:5-7 NLT)

There are relationships to navigate, health issues to live with or work your way through, there is hot or chilly weather that can impact our enjoyment of the day, let alone floods, fire, storms and cyclones. Then there can be the loss and grief we feel when someone dies or moves away or we lose a friendship, must move to a new home, lose our mobility, when a child starts daycare or finishes school. Life is full of changes that impact us. Life never sits still, unchanged, although we may think that it never changes. Change is a part of life whether we like it or not. Change also comes through the good times, buying a new car, seeing loved ones you haven't seen in a while, the birth of a child whether your child or your grandchild, a new job, a new volunteer opportunity, making new friends, learning new things. the church never changes, but it does. Ministers come and go, people move away and some sadly die, some groups close and new ones like Chatty Tuesday start up. Through all the difficulties of life there is one constant in our lives, God. The God of creation who knew us before we were even born, who beckons us to follow Jesus, is there with us in the thick of it all.

We think we can figure life out by ourselves, but realistically we often mess up when we go it alone. We need something or someone outside of ourselves a God who draws us near, who comforts us in our sorrows and celebrates with us in our joyous times. When we lean into God, God will show us the path to take, what decision to make and what direction to take when we are at a crossroads and are feeling uncertain. We don't want to be stuck in the barren desert wandering procrastinating like the Israelites did for forty years. When changes need to be made, we often think we should have all the answers. We don't have to do things all on our own, God is there talking to us through the Bible, through events or through other people who have trodden a similar path. God does not leave us alone, if we have the eyes to see, the ears to listen and a heart that can be transformed. If we dig deeply into God, we may see a vision for the path we are to take. I know from attending Blue Care's Memory Support Café for those who are caring for someone with Dementia or memory loss what a relief it is for those who attend to know that others may have some understanding of the challenges they are going through. The knowledge and experience of others can have a significant impact on how we meander through our journey. It can change our attitude from negative and feeling that there is no chance that things will improve to one of hope for the future. We must not be impressed with our own wisdom, thinking we have all the answers. Let us be brave and give it to God and see what happens.


