

MINISTER'S PASTORAL MESSAGE:

Dear Friends,

Jesus said: "Go to all peoples everywhere and make them my disciples: baptize them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, and teach them to obey everything I have commanded you." (Matthew 28:19-20a GNT)

Did you know that UnitingCare's Connect100+ provide me with a mission coach? The other day during our session, my coach commented that most of our conversation revolved around our property matters. How did it come to be like this? Jesus' great commission stated for us to go everywhere and make him disciples, not go out and build/repair buildings. Recently I have found some historical document treasures. One I didn't initially see as a treasure as it seemed to be written in a foreign language. The strange numbers were pounds, shillings and pence! This offering book was from St Andrew's Presbyterian Church Tiaro and dated from 1959 - 1961. It also recorded where the church services were held. Did you know Tiaro went out into places like Gundiah, Antiqua and Theebine as well as Bauple? They went out past the walls of their church busily spreading the good news to the smaller rural areas.

Another treasure I found was the Walker Street Methodist's 100 years booklet from 1972. Dr IH Grimmett, President of the Qld Conference, wrote: "No one can measure the work of God. Tabulation of numbers, records of buildings and activities, and the naming of names, are signs and guarantees of what the Holy Spirit has made us as servants of Jesus the Lord... Our witness to Jesus as Lord. not our acceptance by men, is what controls us. We are concerned to present and to obey Him faithfully as the Spirit gives us power and opportunity. To be found always faithful and fully available to Him is the real measure of success and failure." The Primitive Methodist Church began in an unoccupied shop or warehouse in March Street in 1872 that was later converted into a

church. It functioned until 1897 when all services were held at Walker Street which had been built and opened in January 1877. They went out beyond the walls of the church holding church services in Bauple, Tiaro, Yengarie, Yerra, Theebine, Thompsen's Flat, Munna Creek, Miva, Gunalda, Torbanlea and Howard as well as building a church at Pialba in 1908 and Fairfield in 1956. For these churches, there weren't many church buildings, instead they used whatever buildings they could use from those communities.

We also have a rich missional history with the likes of St Stephen's Hospital, BlueCare, Lifeline, and Meals on Wheels that are all still part of our region providing support where needed. I love the history of Girls' Brigade. Having begun on 21 June 1964 before we became the Uniting Church, as different churches closed they moved from church hall to church hall, eventually landing in the Wesley Auditorium. They can function out of any building where there is the space for them and their goods and chattels. We can get so stuck in the past and the notion that the buildings are the most important asset we have. They aren't! The people are the most important asset that a church has, people who believe in our Lord Jesus Christ and love the Lord with all their hearts, minds and souls. Other treasures I have found in the past year or two are structural engineering reports from 1993 and 1998. They tell stories of the ongoing issues with our St Stephen's complex, the reactive clay soil that expands in the wet and contracts in the dry weather, creating havoc for our buildings as they age. The building issues are complex and not easy to contend with. I know I would much rather be focussing on our mission and Jesus' great commission than worrying about our buildings, but this is the season we are in.

What do we gain from all our work? I know the heavy burdens that God has laid on us. He has set the right time for everything. He has given us a desire to know the future, but never gives us the satisfaction of fully understanding what he does. (Ecclesiastes 3:9-12 GNT)


